We are aware of recent media regarding this event. I wish to clarify that this is not an initiative of the Australian Government. I am conscious of the concerns raised by yourself and others regarding the timing of the event. I apologise for the delay in responding to your email, I have been trying to confirm if the timing of the event has now changed so it no longer coincides with Mother's Day and my understanding is that this is now confirmed. The Australian Government acknowledges the numerous complex issues regarding intercountry adoption. Community education and campaigns about intercountry adoption need to be sensitive to the experiences of those on all sides of the intercountry adoption triangle.

Your comments are valued and I wish to thank you for sharing them with the Government.
